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### VISIT 1: Mondial College

<b>Name of school</b>	<b>Mondial College</b>

<b>Short presentation of the school</b>	<p>Mondial College is a secondary school for all pupils that leave primary education with the advice to start on a pre-vocational level of secondary education (in Dutch: VMBO, which means preparation for mediate level vocational education). At the VMBO-level, sub levels are distinguished (basic, midlevel, practice-theory based level). All students at Mondial college, regardless their sub level are welcome. During their time in secondary education (mostly four years), pupils are choosing a profile that serves as a preparation for vocational education or work, based on their abilities. These profiles are: Production, technical installations and energy (PIE), Building, living and interior (BWI), Economics and entrepreneurship (E&amp;O), Health and care (Z&amp;W), Food industry and recreation (HBR).</p> <p>The mission of the school is supporting pupils to embrace and develop their talents. Especially on the subject of technology, the school stimulates the curiosity and interest of the pupils by executing classes in the FutureLAB. The Mondial College is the first secondary school with such a lab. Pupils at Mondial college learn about technological solutions, robotics, home automation and VR by experiencing the possibilities themselves. This makes them more aware of the increasing importance of technology in society and care and gives them the possibilities to explore their talents for future work in this field. Short presentation of the school	<p>We are a school for primary education which teaches children with special educational needs that cannot be taught in regular primary education.</p> <p>To adapt to the needs of our pupils, we are working with individual learning plans based on development lines. Our pupils are placed in rather small groups of approximately 15 children so we can address every need and talent with enough time and attention. As a team, we feel a strong pedagogical climate and professional class management is mandatory for letting our pupil grow and learn.</p> <p>What we are proud of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- OGO. Every afternoon we let our pupil work in a rich learning environment on the basic goals of language development, world orientation and culture orientation, based on the principles of constructive alignment. We offer them their lessons theme based and cross-curricular. We are assessed as 'excellent' in 2018 on this method.</li> <li>- ICT. Every pupil learns to work with ICT-tool throughout the full curriculum. We strengthen the position of basic ICT-skills in this way.</li> <li>- SEO (social-emotional development): School broad attention is given to the social and emotional development of our pupils. De way personnel and pupils are approaching each other is aligned and consequently monitored and assessed. This adds to the feeling of safety and a calm learning environment.</li> <li>- Quality assessments. We do have a strong cycle of quality assesments that is executed by trained professionals within the school.</li> </ul> <p>The educational quality inspection visit in 2021 granted us the grade 'good'.</p>
