Pupils who start the "ARTISTIC FORMATION" program in the first grade of this secondary school can choose from seven options: DANCE, MUSIC, WORD (drama) , ARCHITECTURE, CREATION and FASHION, MEDIA, or VISUAL ARTS.

Looking to start later? No problem!

There are also entry opportunities in the_second year of the first grade, the second grade (third and fourth year of secondary education) and the fifth year of secondary education. In the second grade, students choose from a wide range of performing or visual arts. In the third grade they can specialize their chosen field from a selection of 12 different study curriculums.
