Short presentation of the	The Jonge Helden Academie offers programs for young people in
school	The Jonge Heiden Academie offers programs for young people in the ages of 16 to 25 that want to be supported in discovering their strengths and abilities in relation to education, employment, and entrepreneurship. Sometimes they dropped out of regular education, but also young people that wish to start their own business and are in need of a role model that can discuss the steps needed to start as an entrepreneur are very welcome. By exploring talents and making the participants aware of what is needed to flourish, but also acknowledging what is not suitable or possible in their personal situation, a more detailed insight in their strengths and possibilities arises. In our programs participants discover their unique potential and learn to use these talents and new discovered skills in their best step forward in education, employment and entrepreneurship.

Short presentation of the school	The Karel de Grote College is secondary school for Waldorf Education. In Waldorf education, the learning process is essentially threefold, engaging head, heart, and hands—or thinking, feeling, and doing. With this method we try to develop the whole human being and not just the intellectual capacities. Besides the cognitive subjects, we offer a range of movement and artistic subjects like eurythmy, woodwork, needlework, drama, painting and drawing, music, choir singing etc. The development of our students into independently thinking human beings is the main goal of our education. We try to inspire life-long learning in all students and to enable them to fully develop their unique capacities. Our school has around 800 students and 80
