



Kivilinna Kool (Primary Education)



Municipal basic school (grades 1-9)

900 students, 66 teachers

Operates in its current form since 2014

Admission of students based on residence

Core values: kindness and thoughtfulness

Objective: that the students become self-guided, creative and co-operative, so they strive in a changing world.

School day starts at 8.00, lessons are 45 minutes long. Extended schooldays in grades 1 and 2 to support social and learning skills.

Five study periods, evaluation twice in a school year.

Formative assessment in grades 1-3

In grades 4-9 non-differentiated assessment in some subjects

Study Success Centre comprises support staff (psychologist, social pedagogue, special education teacher, tutor) for children with special needs and learning difficulties.

English taught from grade 1, second foreign language from grade 3. PE lessons in grades 1, 4 and 5 are dance lessons

Project weeks integrating subjects

Creative Project in grade 8, accompanied by written report

Extracurricular activities: robotics, choirs, science club, drama club, woodworking, media club, math club, communication, sewing, folk dance etc
