4. What is the expected impact of the project in the field? What are the related measures?
5. What is the collective professional development of researchers and practitioners involved in this project?
6. What kind of products has the project produced as intellectual outcomes, e.g. publications, tools, websites, presentations, ... (i.e. degree of dissemination)
7. What is the sustainability of the project, or these products?
8. What are the three most important lessons learned/conclusions during the course of the project?
